TODDLER, EARLY CHILDHOOD & ELEMENTARY FIRST-DAY ITEMS

ITEMS THAT YOUR STUDENT NEEDS TO BRING TO SCHOOL ON THE FIRST DAY

(PLEASE LABEL EVERY ITEM WITH CHILD'S NAME)

TODDLER AND EARLY CHILDHOOD

- 1 pair washable indoor shoes like Crocs or canvas slip-on shoes. (Rubber soles instead of slippers better protect the children's feet in case of a fire drill or other emergency.) No big, fuzzy slippers or flip flops, please.
- 1 emergency comfort kit - instructions below
- A complete set of extra clothes, including underwear and socks.
- **Toddler Students:** While toilet learning, ample extra pants and underwear (4-6 sets) are also requested. 5 Diapers or undergarments, daily. (No "pull-ups")
- **Toddler & Early Childhood Students:** All full day Toddlers, 3 year olds and any 4 year olds who still nap, need to bring a fitted crib sheet and a small crib size light weight blanket. Label these with the child's name using a laundry pen. They may be sent home on Friday to be washed and returned on Monday.

ELEMENTARY

- 1 pair washable indoor shoes like crocs or canvas slip-on shoes (Rubber soles instead of slippers better protect the children's feet in case of a fire drill or other emergency.) No big, fuzzy slippers or flip flops, please.
- Small, washable, and reusable water bottle.
- 1 emergency Comfort Kit – instructions below

COMFORT KIT INSTRUCTIONS

The emergency comfort kits are brought to school on the first day and returned at the end of the school year. They are to be used in case of major emergency such as severe earthquake or storm. Items will be sent home on the last day of school and a new kit returned to school on the first day back.

Please assemble the kit as described below and bring to school. All of these things must fit into a **1 gal. size Ziploc bag**, labeled on both sides with your child's name. Do not substitute containers please - we have a limited storage space.

CONTENTS OF COMFORT KIT: - We provide water and juice.
- Do not send items that may be harmed by freezing.
- Check expiration dates when you purchase.

Any substitutions that are made to suit your child's own tastes - please bear in mind that they must have a shelf life of 1 year.

If there is any medication that your child must take daily, see Receptionist to arrange an emergency supply at school.

* *Space blankets are sold at R.E.I., Big Five, and most other sporting goods stores. They are made of space age material designed to hold in body heat. Do not send other blankets.*
